- Master's degree in social work, psychology, counseling, marriage and family therapy, or related field and a clinical mental health license required, plus at least 6 years' experience providing clinical behavioral health services to children and youth; preference for a clinician with experience providing clinical behavioral health services to children, youth, and adults.
